We Appologize

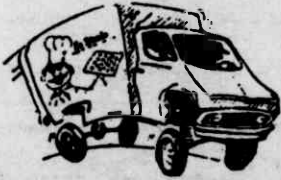
In last month's issue one of the captions of the Women's Division of Federations' photos should have included Renee Gorelick's name. She is the trips chairwoman.
