According to Joseph Rosenstein, Chairperson of the August Institute, and overall chair of the planning committee, "The most astonishing thing about the Havurah Institute is that the participants give up a week of their precious vacation time to study and prepare courses for which they will receive no credit. They participate joyously, giving enormously of themselves, and deriving the greatest satisfaction and inspiration from their shared efforts."

The morning courses are part of a total program including workshops, forums, entertainment and recreational activities. A special feature of this summer's institutes will be group projects involving institute participants in such activities as

the creation of objects of art; dance, music and dramatic performances; the writing of school curricula and creative prayers, as well as many other efforts intended to benefit the entire institute community.


