## First UJA "Select Singles" Mission

NEW YORK, N.Y. — The United Jewish Appeal announced a new national mission to Israel for single men and women ages 35 and over. H. Paul Rosenberg, the national Chairman of UJA Overseas Programs said that the mission, scheduled for May 21-31, is one of a series of innovative programs to encourage the involvment of single Jews in UJA/community campaigns.

The mission is designed to give participants an opportunity to share the experience of visiting Israel with other mature singles, broaden their understanding of Jewish needs, and strengthen their commitment to Israel and the Jewish community.

Participants will receive briefings by representatives of the Jewish Agency for Israel and the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee and will have the opportunity to see first-hand the social welfare programs and facilities that improve the quality of life for the people of Israel.

Other highlights include visits with pioneers in the Galilee and new immigrants from Ethiopia, and home hospitality in a Project Renewal neighborhood. A special feature of the mission will be
