The JCC Child Care Center is a cozy, clean, childproofed house right next door to the Hebrew Academy at 910 Sardis Lane. It's open for four-month to twenty-eight month-olds on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. for \$25M/\$30NM every two weeks (camp sessions). Come September, parents will have a choice of one, two or three days-a-week for nine months of child care. A registration fee of \$20 will be good September 1985 through May 1986. Parents will be expected to commit to a particular day or days (Monday, Wednesday and/or Friday) for the nine months, paying \$6.50 per day members of the JCC; \$8 non-members.

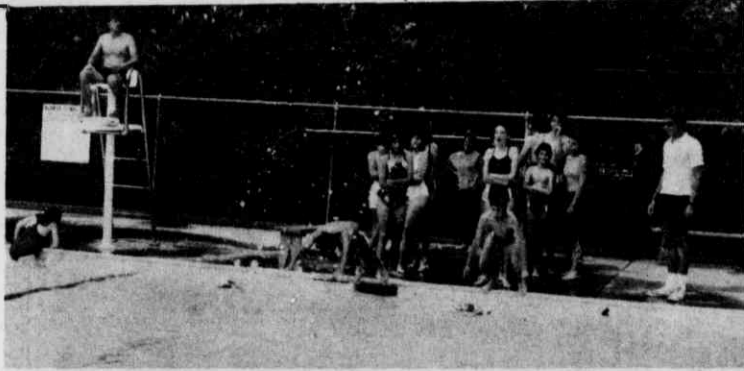
