Israel Bonds Honored Rabbi Rocklin

On October 27 approximately 200 people attended the annual Israel Bond Dinner at Adam's Mark. They came to honor Rabbi Richard Rocklin and to hear a stirring address from David Schoenbrun, noted TV broadcaster, author and journalist.

Rabbi Rocklin was presented the United Jerusalem City of Peace Award for his continuing commitment to the State of Israel.

The dinner was the keynote of the annual drive to promote the sale of Israel Bonds, a major source of developmental capital for Israel. Proceeds from bond sales are channeled through Israel's development budget to help finance industrial and agricultural projects and construction of highways, harbors and new towns.

Under the direction of Rabbi Marc Wilson, the Adam's Mark prepared a strictly kosher dinner. The necessary kosher utensils have been stored and will be available for future kosher affairs.
