Black & White Cake

If you have a bit of milk that has begun to go sour and you can't bear to throw it away, try this marble cake recipe.

- 2 cups sugar 2 sticks margarine 4 eggs, separated
- 1/3 cup cocoa
- 3 cups flour
- 3 cups flour 3 tsps. baking powder
- 1 cup sour milk
- 1/4 cup almonds



Cream sugar and margarine. Add egg yolks and beat. Mix flour with baking powder and add alternately with the milk. Take off about one-half of the batter and add cocoa. In another bowl beat egg whites until they are stiff. Fold half the egg whites into chocolate mixture and the other half into the white mixture. Fold almonds into the chocolate mixture. Grease two loaf pans. Pour half the white mixture into each loaf pan. Top with chocolate mixture. Bake at 350 degrees about 35-40 minutes. Test with toothpick to see if done.

Frozen Fruit Salad

Frozen fruit salad can be used as a side dish with tuna and egg salad or as a dessert. It adds a festive air to an otherwise ordinary meal.

1 cup drained crushed pineapple 1 cup fruit cocktail, well drained 1/3 cup chopped pecans 2 cups sour cream 2 tbls. lemon juice 34 cup sugar

Mix all ingredients together. Pour into a $3\frac{1}{2}$ cup mold or bowl. Freeze. Serves 8-10.
