Prof. Allen Pollack, prominent lecturer, writer and community leader, now lives in Israel where he serves as Educational Consultant of the United Israel Appeal of Canada and the United Israel Appeal of the United States.

Born in New York, he was educated at Columbia University, the University of Stockholm (Sweden), and Princeton University. He was a Duke Foundation Fellow and under a Ford Foundation Grant, was a visiting Fellow at the Marx-Engels-Lenin Institute of the University of Leningrad. Prof. Pollack's field of academic specialization is Russian History and the role of the Jews in the Revolutionary Movement of Czarist Russia. He has taught at Brooklyn College, the University of Pittsburgh and Yeshiva University.


Long active in Jewish communal affairs, he was a member of the Executive Board of
