"The JCC arranged for my family to remain active members. My son was able to continue at the Hebrew Academy. Then, when my grandmother needed it, the Blumenthal Home worked it out for her to be admitted.

"I'm back on my feet now and paying my way again. I'll never forget how the Federation and everyone else helped when I needed it."
