On Sunday, February 21 from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., there will be a Barrier Awareness Day held at Shalom Park in Gorelick Hall. This will be for both children and adults and will present an opportunity to experience first hand what it means to be physically disabled. Metrolina Independent Living Center will be in charge of the program which is free of charge to members of the Jewish community.

Cosponsors of the program will be Jewish Family Services' Task Force on the Physically Disabled, the Foundation of the Charlotte Jewish Community, HaLailah Chapter of B'nai B'rith Women, the Jewish Community Center, Temple Beth El V'Shalom and Temple Israel. HaLailah will provide a free lunch at 1 p.m. An award will be given to the person in the Jewish community who has done the most for the physically disabled.


