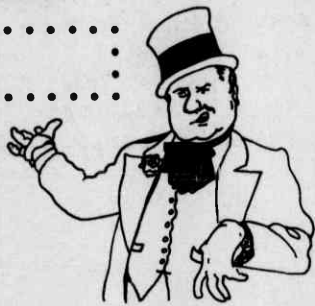

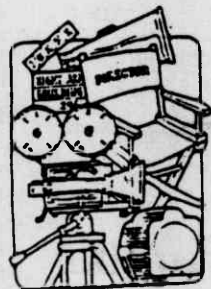
FINANCIAL PLANNING FOR SMALL BUSINESS OWNERS
