## Jewish Day School Holds Rabin Memorial

Students and teachers at the Jewish Day School of Charlotte were shocked to learn about the horrible tragedy that occurred in Israel, the assassination of Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin.

On Monday, November 6, the entire school assembled for a special memorial service. Rabbi Binyomin Weiss led the service by reciting Psalms with the children. He spoke with emotion as he explained to the children the sad ramifications of the tragedy.
