



Each participant is asked to bring a favorite humorous selection to share with the group. Perhaps it might be a short story, a humorous anecdote, a short recording of a Jewish comedian (or comedience) even a TV clip for the VCR. It's up to you.

The selection for the February 26 meeting has an entirely different focus. A Scrap of Time, by Ida Fink, is a haunting collection of stories about life in Poland during World War II. The vivid descriptions of small town life and scenes as experienced by Polish Jews during the "actions" (round ups for the Nazi imposed forced labor) make this one of the most notable Holocaust writings: compelling and poignant at the same time.
