

Miep Gies, Otto Frank's secretary who delivered supplies to the inhabitants of the annex during the war, found the diary after the Frank family was discovered and arrested in 1944. Anne died of typhus in the Bergen-Belsen concentration camp in 1945. Gies returned the diary to Otto, the family's only survivor, after he was liberated from Auschwitz.

Exploris, which opened in October 1999, is dedicated to encouraging people of all ages to respect differences and make connections with people around the world. The facility is located at 201 East Hargett Street in downtown Raleigh. Admission is \$6.95 for adults, \$5.95 for seniors, \$4.95 for children under 12, and \$3.95 per person for groups of 10 or more. The Anne Frank exhibit is scheduled to run for two years.
