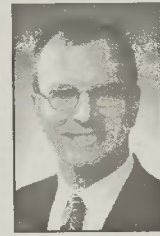
Planned Giving News

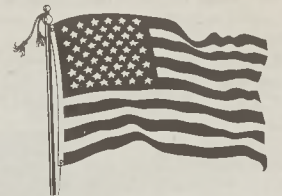

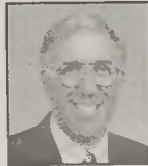
