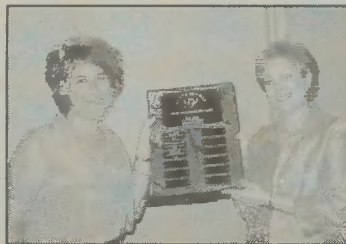

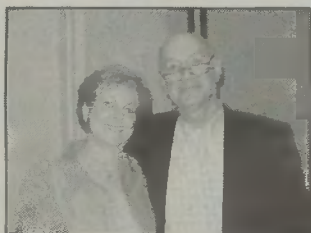
Mary Wojnowich, Lion of Judah co-chair, presents new Lion Adrienne Gossett with her pin.

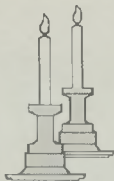
