In eight hours, 68 volunteers from twelve agencies closed 500 cards and raised \$56,051 representing a 21% card for card increase. The Jewish Federation appreciates the efforts of all of our agencies and volunteers who donated their time to make this day a success.

Super Sunday co-chairs Crystal Ben-Yohanan and Elaine Moody wanted to make the day fun for the volunteers who called between the hours of 9 AM-1 PM and 5-9 PM. Volunteers made phone calls, emailed pledge acknowledgements, wrote thank you notes, and assisted in the effort to call over 2,000 people.
