Because of the transient nature of Charlotte and the Jewish community of the 21st century in general, many families are separated by great distances. This has left young Jewish families and singles without the local multigenerational support structure that was so readily available in past genera-tions. With so many activities vying for the attention of today's young Jews and the increasing rates of interfaith marriages and assimilation in general, it is becoming more challenging to ensure future generations share a strong sense of Jewish identity. It

has also left many "Empty Nesters" and seniors without the strong ties to the Jewish community they had while raising their families.

The idea arose to bridge this gap by connecting the two groups. Bernstein Leadership Group Class VI and Jewish Family Services are joining forces to launch a small pilot program by fall called Big Bubbies/Big Zaydes. The purpose of Big Bubbies/Big Zaydes is to foster Jewish continuity and community by connecting young families in the Charlotte community with those who are more established.

The goals of the group are:

1. Provide young Jewish families with a source of guidance, Jewish history and family tradi-tions. 2. Provide Jewish "Empty Nesters" and seniors with a connection into the younger Jewish community in Charlotte and the opportunity to feel needed, especially around Shabbat and other Jewish holidays.

Singles of all ages moving to Charlotte are also encouraged to participate. Oftentimes, it takes being 'adopted' by someone more established to ease the way into

becoming an active member of the Jewish commu

There are any dy ten young families lined up to ate in the program. We are not shif attention to identifying potential "bigs" who ensure the pilot is a success and leads to the roll-out of a large gram. There's no rigid schedule, no fixed number of hours, just a willingness to listen and share. There's such richness we can bring to each other. If you, or
