New Torah to Honor Life and Legacy of **Israel Schwartz**

Torah Dedication on December 7

A new Torah scroll will be completed and dedicated at 12 noon on Sunday, December 7, at Congregation Ohr HaTorah in Charlotte. The Torah, which was inscribed in the holy city of Jerusalem, was launched by Larry Schwartz in memory of his father Mr. Israel (Lou) Schwartz. Lou Schwartz was the founder UCS Track and Field, which is now headquartered in Lincolnton, NC.

Mr. Lou Schwartz was a known philanthropist in New Jersey, where he founded his company which is now headed by his sons Jeff and Larry Schwartz. Lou was an excellent craftsman who descended from a long line of tailors back in what was then called Czechoslovakia (now the Czech Republic). Lou had particular expertise in pattern-making, cutting, and sewing. Together with his wife Margaret and his sons, he expanded the company to manufacture track and field equipment and strength and speed equipment, as well as gym mats, seating, and

Today UCS is headquartered in a 130,000 square foot facility in
