office, American-born Israeli historian Efraim Zuroff coordinates the center's worldwide effort to locate Nazi war criminals and bring them to justice.

In a career spanning 28 years he has not only tracked down those who helped perpetrate the Holocaust, but also convinced often-hesitant governments to prosecute them. Zuroff stresses that the project is not only part of the fight for justice, but also an important component of the struggle for historical truth.

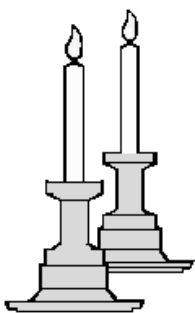
Topic "Beauty Tips for the Professional Woman"
