Special satellite stations were set up on Main Street and at the entrance to the Levine JCC Gym from 9 AM-1 PM to create awareness for Super Sunday and to make it easy for donors to make a pledge. Donors making a pledge at the satellite stations were given "I made my pledge on Super Sunday" stickers to wear.

For donors who wanted to call back and provide a pledge, the 24 Hour Pledge Hotline was up and ready to receive those donations.

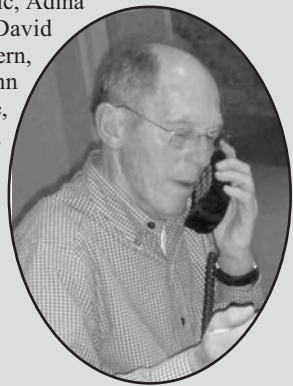
