John Charles Kunich is currently a Fulbright Senior Specialist in Law serving at the Indian Law Institute in New Delhi, India, where he teaches comparative environmental law to Ph.D. and LL.M. students. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in Biological Sciences with Highest Honors from the University of Illinois at Chicago in 1975. He went on to earn a Master of Science degree in Entomology from the same university in 1979, with Highest Honors.

Professor Kunich has extensive experience in the mass media. He has appeared on televised news broadcasts on MSNBC, PBS, and Fox News. Professor Kunich was one of only a handful of experts featured in a major CNN International television special, broadcast around the world in late 2004. His quotes have appeared many times in USA Today as well as Christian Science Monitor, Kansas City Star, and other major newspapers.
