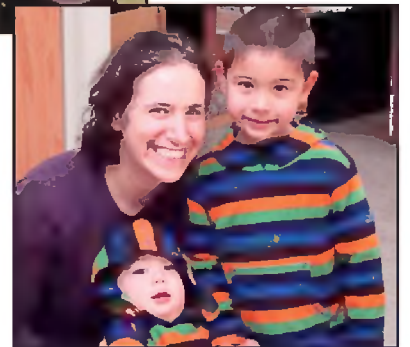

Thank you to all of you in our community who continue to support the efforts of Hadassah.

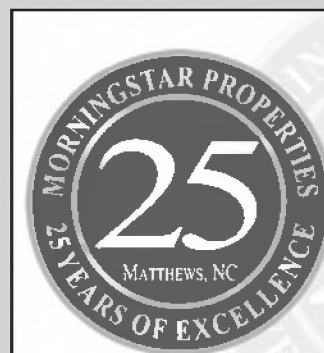
