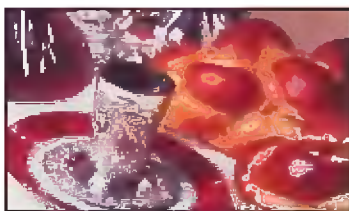

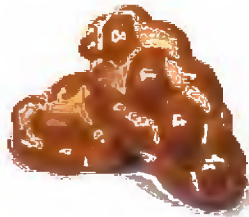


dough, from regular braided challahs to napkin rings, baskets, and much more, there is something for everyone.

Rabbi Yosef Levanon will be joining Temple Kol Ami as our Guest-Scholar-in-Residence on the weekend of November 2.

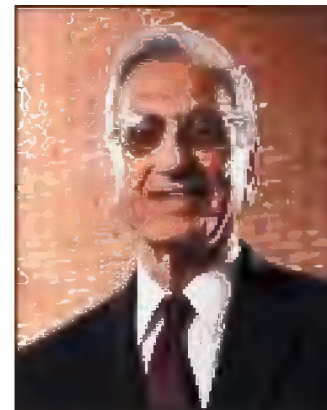
