Shmurah Matza Available at Ohr HaTorah

A beautiful tradition in many Jewish communities is the use of round Shmurah Matza for the Passover Seder. Some of the reasons for this custom include that the Shmurah Matza is the closest replication of the original Matza the children of Israel ate when they left Egypt in haste. This is especially true of the hand-baked Shmurah Matza where no machinery is used and the matza is prepared and baked by hand in the old fashioned way.

In addition the Shmurah Matza is baked with extra care which begins from the time of selecting and milling the grains for wheat.


Thus the name Shmurah which means guarded. The matza is made of only two ingredients, natural unbleached wheat and pure well water. The entire process of baking the matza including the mixing and kneading needs to be completed in less than 18 minutes.

The matzo is baked in an old style brick oven fired by wood logs which reach very high temperature. The average time it takes to bake the matza is less than three minutes. The matza bakery shuts down production every 18 minutes and goes in to a total scrub down. After a careful in-



spection of all the hand equipment the bakery starts up again. The oven remains fired up all day as the intense heat helps sanitize the oven interior.





