## Jewish Federation Annual Meeting will Feature World Renowned Solo Theater Performer Robbie Gringras

ing in Israel since 1996. As such his work – educational and theatrical – bridges the Israel - Diaspora connection with empathy and insight. He has been credited with “being a provocative

entertainer helping to build intimate, honest, open relations between Israel and the Diaspora.”

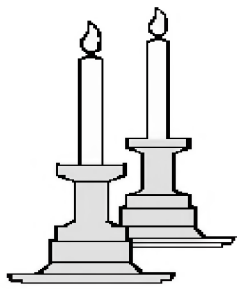
