

JCRC Lecture featuring Ralph Nurnberger, May 8

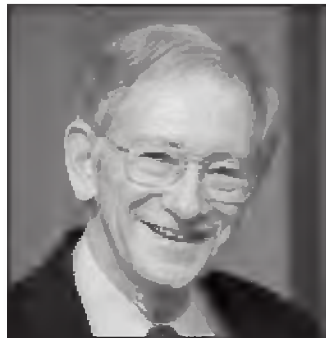
The Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte's Community Relations Council (JCRC) welcomes Dr. Ralph Nurnberger to Charlotte on Wednesday, May 8, 7:30 PM at Temple Israel. Dr. Nurnberger will lecture on the Implications of US and Israeli Policies on the Middle East.

Dr. Ralph Nurnberger is a widely acclaimed speaker who brings humor, current political insights and historical background to his presentations. His amazing sense of humor, sociability and depth of knowledge about the view of Israel from Washington earned him accolades when he spoke at Federation's Major Gift event in 2011.

Dr. Nurnberger is a Professor of International Relations at Georgetown University. His articles have appeared in *The Washington Post*, *The Washington Times*, *Miami Herald*, *Los Angeles Times*, *Baltimore Sun* and numerous scholarly journals and magazines. His most recent book is entitled *Lobbying in America*.

He served on Capitol Hill, in

the Executive Branch as a staff member on the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, and was in the field of government relations for twenty five years. In addition, Dr. Nurnberger spent over eight years as a Congressional Liaison for the American Israel Public Affairs Committee (AIPAC).

dealt with many international leaders. Among them were Israeli Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin, then-Foreign Minister Shimon Peres and PLO Chairman Yasser Arafat, as well as American and international business and political leaders.
