As you look forward to celebrating a New Year we hope you consider making a commitment to Hadassah.

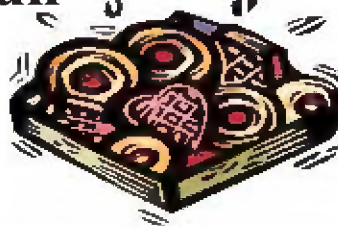
