Holocaust Education Day at Shalom Park

On Tuesday, October 1, 111 8th grade middle school students from Charlotte Latin School attended the joint Butterfly Project and Holocaust Education Day at Shalom Park. Students participated in learning workshops focused on prejudice, discrimination, religious tolerance, and lessons learned from the Holocaust. Students had the opportunity to visit the Margaret and Lou Schwartz Butterfly Garden and hand paint ceramic butterflies in memory of the children who perished. In addition, students heard from Holocaust survivor Suly Chenkin as well as Dor Hollander, our current Israeli Shaliach, who made a presentation about modern day Israel. Rives Wedding, 8th grade teacher, who accompanied the students, commented, "I would love to see this become part of our curriculum. It definitely added so much to the students' reading and discussions in

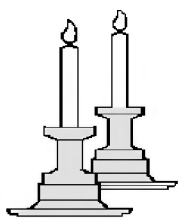
