

Tribefest: March 16-18, Sheraton Hotel, New Orleans

Thousands of young Jewish adults will gather in New Orleans for The Jewish Federations of North America's (JFNA) TribeFest 2014. The marquee event for young Jews will gather major speakers, hit musical acts, and scores of leading Jewish organizations under the Jewish Federations' tent in the Big Easy, March 16-18. TribeFest 2014, based at the Sheraton New Orleans, will feature transformational programming to engage and inspire young Jews. Previous TribeFest headliners have included Hollywood actress Mayim Bialik, "Saturday Night Live" star Rachel Dratch, best-selling humorist and author A.J. Jacobs, Olympic gold-medal swimmer Lenny Krayzelburg, Idealist.org founder Ami Dar, and author of "The Accidental Billionaires," Ben Mezrich.

TribeFest, for Jews ages 22-45, offers a diverse range of experiences and events. Participants can choose from workshops, panel discussions, community service opportunities and social events. Programs will focus on issues such as Jewish environmentalism, social activism in Israel, Jews in pop culture, and more.

"TribeFest provides a lens for young adults to see the various ways they can engage and participate in Jewish life in their communities," said Jerry Silverman, president and CEO of JFNA. "We have seen the profound effects that this exciting and inspirational program has on Jewish young adults. We look forward to traveling to New Orleans next year, and have already begun to build an outstanding program."

The cost per person for registration for TribeFest is \$450 prior to January 20 and \$499 after. Hotel rooms are \$199/night for single occupancy. The Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte is offering subsidies. Subsidy applications are available at NEXTGEN-Charlotte.org.

TribeFest is the seminal event for young Jews to come together to connect to their own Judaism, to the Jewish community, and to other young Jews from across North America.
