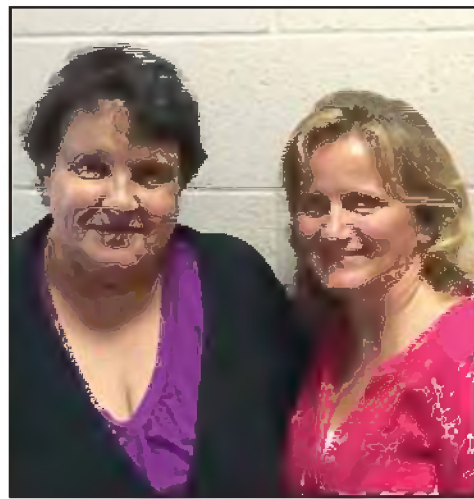

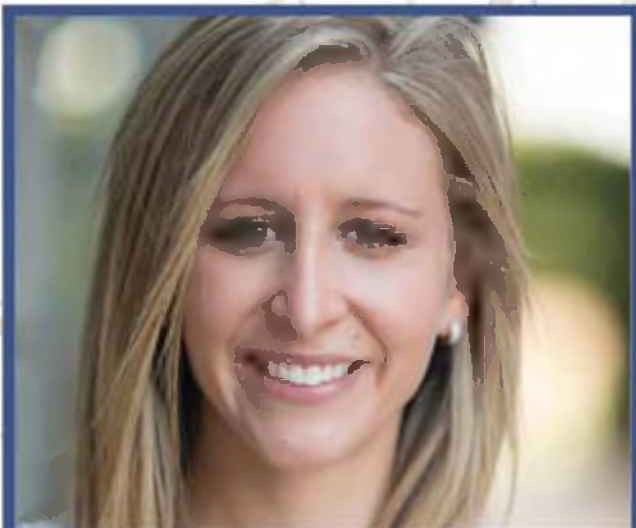
JPS Board members: I am grateful for your talents, your time, and your dedication to helping JPS thrive.
