My parents told me, "Adelaide, the Torah should be a blueprint for your life's plan. Heed its stories; use their morals and apply them to your stories. When you're lost, think not as a person, but as a Jew."

I may live in the Diaspora, but Zionism dominates my identity as a Jew, so much so that I decided to spend my summer learning Israel's history (tests and essays such as this included).

A few thousand miles east, from where I sit here in Israel, every rocket from Gaza feels as if it is putting my family, my people, in danger. I find my heart in an entirely Jewish country.

Here is a land that, to some, G-d promised to Abraham. To others, it's a land conquered and defended by Israeli forces time and time again. To me, it's both and everything in between.

As I contemplate the history of our people and my future, I'm grateful that I started my Jewish journey at the Charlotte Jewish Day School. I'd like to somehow make a difference in the world, and I think being Jewish is taking me on the right path.
