

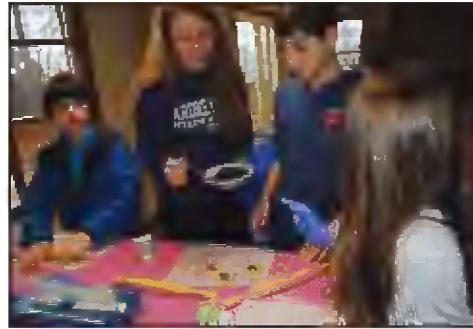

His compassion extends well beyond Shalom Park. For example, Alan and his wife, Merle, have led the effort to prepare and serve breakfast at a shelter on Christmas morning for the past 17 years.

Though Alan left the Brotherhood Board, he didn't stop caring or contributing. Along with the first Man of Distinction award winner, Howard Epstein, and with help from Amy Weingarten and Barry Ezarsky, Alan has overseen the development of the Brother-

hood Star of Life that was rededicated at the Brotherhood Shabbat on March 20. Besides being beautiful artwork, the Brotherhood Star of Life accomplishes two critical goals – it provides Beth El congregants a way to honor the people they love and acknowledge cherished events in their lives and will raise about \$150,000 in Endowment in support of Temple Beth El.

As proud as Alan is of the Brotherhood and Temple Beth El, he's even more proud and in love with his wife Merle, his daughters Melissa and Dana, and his two sweet grandchildren. Alan is the Temple Beth El Brotherhood Man of Distinction this year but he's really been a distinguished man all his life. ✪
