### Film Festival Fan Appreciation Day

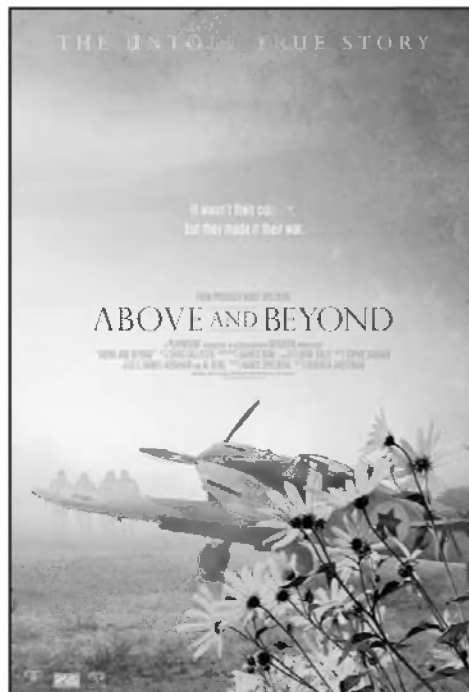
