Park Center is located behind (on the downtown side) of Charlotte's American Legion Football Stadium, which is adjacent to the Central Piedmont Community College campus. The entrance to Park Center is at 310 Kings Drive. There is parking across Kings Drive and on the north side of Park Center on both sides of East Seventh Street.

From I-77

From either direction, take the East Trade Street exit and turn east onto Trade Street in the direction of downtown Charlotte (toward the tall buildings). In about two miles, you'll cross under the I-277 overpass. Turn left at the next light and you're on Kings Drive headed for the parking areas! Go past Park Center (on the right), turn right onto East Seventh, and head into a parking lot! Simple.
