said, "Now, more than ever, it is vitally important that members of Congress hear from constituents who support lifting the ban on lesbian and gay service members. The campaign to repeal 'Don't Ask, Don't Tell, Don't Harass, Don't Pursue' begins in Congress and those joining us in Washington are sending a clear, important message that the days of federally sanctioned discrimination must end now."

"Don't Ask, Don't Tell, Don't Harass, Don't Pursue" is the only US law that authorizes the firing of an American for being gay. The law forces the Pentagon to discharge vital personnel critical for national security, including linguists, doctors, paratroopers and pilots. Since the law was implemented in 1994, the Pentagon has discharged almost 9000 service members.
