Miss Cora Williams has returned from a visit to Mount Gilead, N. C.

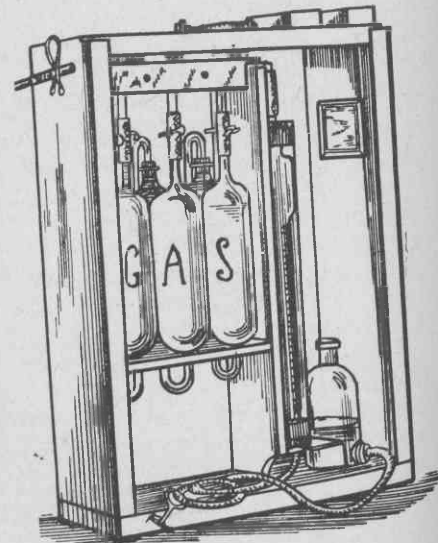
Miss Ruth Kendall has accepted a position in Charlotte, N. C.
