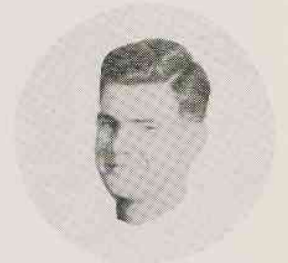

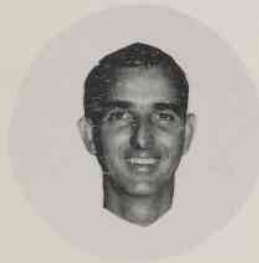
VIC CONARY

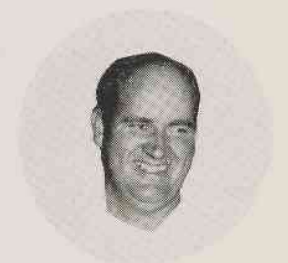
