### Questions

4. What was Piedmont's yield (average revenue per passenger mile) for the first nine months of 1987?

### Answers to questions in October issue

1. Marriott Hotels and Resorts, Omni Hotels, Stouffer Hotels, and The Radisson Hotels are all partners in Piedmont's Frequent Flyer Bonus Program.
2. To join Piedmont's Senior Class Travel Club, a person must be 60 years of age. Piedmont has "Senior Discounts" coupons for sale to persons 62 years or older. The coupons allow senior citizens to fly to any city in the United States served by Piedmont, Henson, The Piedmont Regional Airline, or the Piedmont Commuter System for as little as \$74 each way. Booklets of four or eight coupons are available for \$348 or \$592, respectively, and each coupon is valid for a one-way trip, even if that one-way trip involves a connection.
3. Passengers on our 767-200 flights can turn into one of seven channels: classical, contemporary, jazz, country, and two easy listening, plus a special channel on which music features vary.
4. The YS-11 retired from Piedmont's fleet on March 14, 1982. Piedmont's inaugural flight with this aircraft was on May 19, 1968.
5. With the addition of Nassau on November 15 and both San Diego and Phoenix on December 8, Piedmont will fly to 95 airports.

## ORF, BNARO teams Piedmont softball champs

The Norfolk Men's Softball Team won its eighth consecutive Piedmont title and the BNARO Women's Softball Team, their second title, at the annual Piedmont Softball Tournament, held in Rock Hill, SC, in October.

After two victories on a very rainy Saturday and eventually a postponement, the men's team

went on to take three more games and the title in rescheduled play. Tony Trollinger, GSOMM, who hit a seventh inning, game-winning grand slam home run in the game with DAY, was voted most valuable player. His batting average was 10 for 11 for the tournament. Barry Smith, INT, hit 10 for 10 with one home run in the final day's play.

Tim Spangler, INT, and Greg Curtis, INT, each hit 8 for 11.

Twenty-eight men's teams competed in the tournament. INT-HQ came in second second place followed by DAY in third and CAE in fourth.

the finals by 26-5. BNARO player Cheryl Layman was named most valuable player for the tournament. Seven women's teams participated. It was the second consecutive Piedmont tournament win for the BNARO women.
