## RUBY-THROATED HUMMINGBIRD

Of all the birds which come to us for the summer the Ruby-throated Hummingbirds seem to create the greatest pleasure. This is understandable, because there are so many surprising things to be learned about them and they can be so easily attracted near our homes where we can watch their fascinating ways.

Hummingbirds are our smallest feathered creatures. Of the five hundred to six hundred species, all in the Americas and nowhere else in the world, the Ruby-throated is the only one which comes to Eastern United States. He is neither the smallest nor the largest, but from the tip of his bill to the tip of his tail he measures about three and one half inches and he
