In addition, there will be a baseball diamond, a football field, and a field for Little League baseball and softball. (CONTINUED ON PAGE 21)

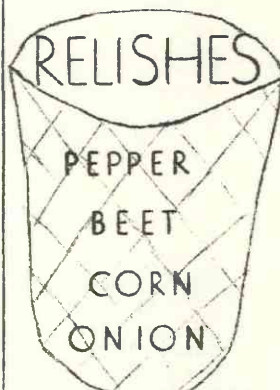
"BULLITT"
