("ARE WE LOSING OUR LIBERTY?" FROM P. 1) except guarded by just laws, which protect the civil rights and the moral dignity of the people. Liberty is a misnomer outside of law and morality. The second table of the divine code applies to murder, adultery, theft, perjury, and covetousness; and underlies the rights of life, property, character, and happiness of all men. Any government which does not fully protect these rights falls short of securing liberty. The first table of the divine code applies to idolatry, the worship of images, profanation of God's name, the observance of the Sabbath, and the obedience and honor of children to their parents. These are matters of religious and domestic life, and must be left to the individual, so long as he does not run counter to public rights and social order. Civil government has nothing to do with my religion (or should not have) my personal character, my family, or my Sabbath, except to protect their rights. Religious liberty and civil liberty, while morally interdependent, are organically independent of each other.

We render unto God, God's; unto Caesar, Caesar's. There is no organic connection whatever between Church and State, between God's kingdom and Caesar's kingdom. Matters of faith do not belong to civil legislation; and civil matters do not belong to church legislation. This is New Testament liberty, which millions (CONTINUED ON PAGE 18)

"THE SOUND OF MUSIC"

Rodgers and Hammerstein's "The Sound of Music," a Robert Wise production, is the film version of one of the most beloved stage musicals of the last decade.
