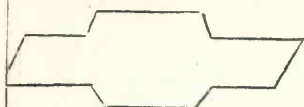

Wrong parts are used in certain areas that result in the same failure to operate. All in all the workmen involved just must not have cared what they did or what they did not do. Hospital workers are not excused when they make errors of any kind, and considering the amount and the types of work done here of a technical and special nature, it is to their credit such criticism is not applicable.
