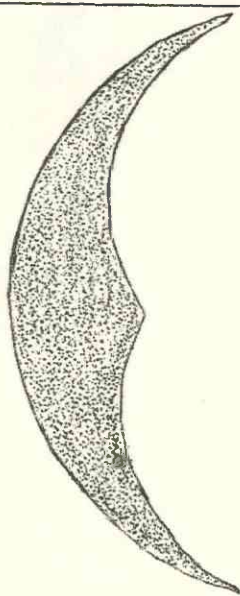
In Psalms 105:2 we find, "Sing unto Him, sing psalms unto Him: talk ye of all his wondrous works."
