"THE LOVE BUG"

Walt Disney's "THE LOVE BUG" is showing at the Galax Theatre Friday and Saturday, June 15-20.

This funny, fast paced picture should have strong appeal for every member of the family. It's one of the best from Disney in some time.

Herbie, an anthropathetic Volkswagen, is the star of this auto-biography. He, (or it), is ably supported by Dean Jones, Michele Lee, David Tomlinson and Buddy Hackett. Picture is a western on wheels but the plot never gets in the way of the entertainment; exciting road races provide continuity structure for sight gags and consistently amusing dialogue.

Excellent camera work by Edward Colman provides scenes of Yosemite Park, Monterey Peninsula and San Francisco that would strengthen any travelogue. For good measure there are shots of the colorful New Year parade in San Francisco China Town, with Herbie masquerading as a dragon, and an exciting scene on Golden Gate Bridge, reminiscent of Harold Lloyd, when Herbie and Dean Jones take turns saving each other from the briny drink.

Real heroes of this fantasy farce, which often pokes fun at itself, are the Special Effects and Special Photographic Effects crew, who make Herbie's antics believably human and his racing accomplishments realistic. The music contributes to the happy quality of this film; even the cast seem to be having a good time.

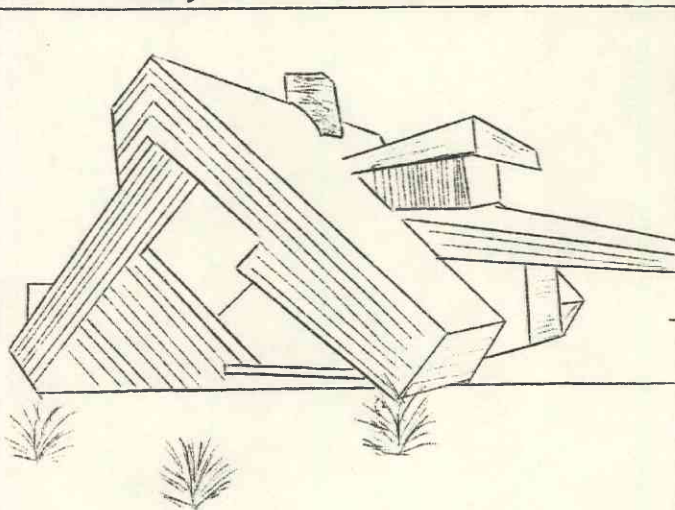
