Mercer, currently head of the Department of Political Science and Public Affairs at Western Carolina University has distinguished himself at several institutions across the state as an outstanding professor of political science and public administration.

Receiving his master's in political science and sociology at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in 1964, he continued his education receiving his doctorate in public administration and political science at the University of Florida in Gainesville in 1971.

Professor Mercer has held several teaching positions besides his current position at Western Carolina, including tenures with the University of Mississippi, the University of Richmond as well as Atlantic Christian College from 1963 to 1965 where he was instrumental in organizing a political science major. Further adding to his list of fine credentials was employment in the National Institute of Education in the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare and a fellowship with the U.S. Office of Education. Mercer has also written several outstanding works for various scholarly periodicals.
