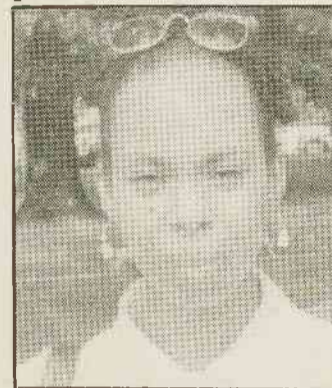

"As women of this college, we cannot afford to take this privilege lightly," she said.

Dr. Alma Adams, art professor in the Humanities Division and NC State Rep. (D) of 26th District urged students to register to vote.

"If you don't vote, you don't have a voice," Adams said.

"President Scott's address to the college was very informative," said Tamara Adams, senior biology major from Sacramento.

"These are critical issues in the African-American community," she added.

Letter Policy

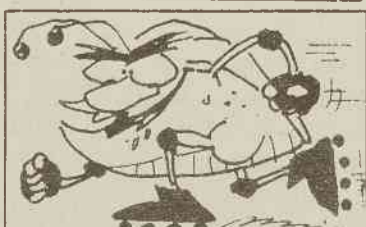
