



We are indebted to Miss Hixie Ashe for the idea promoting the appearance of this photo on the front page. Although she did not mention this spot among the really wonderful sights that Western N. C. affords, we are taking the liberty to show this additional scene that is yours for the trouble of seeing. This is Linville Falls. Here the Linville River makes an abrupt drop of fifty-five feet in the total drop of more than 100 feet from the top of the photo, as shown, to the pool below. Look on N. C. Highway Map, E-2 location. Follow U. S. Highway 221 North from Marion to Newland and you will find Linville Falls. The Falls can be reached either from below the Blue Ridge at Marion, via U. S. 221 or by U. S. 19-E Blowing Rock to Asheville, on top the Blue Ridge.
