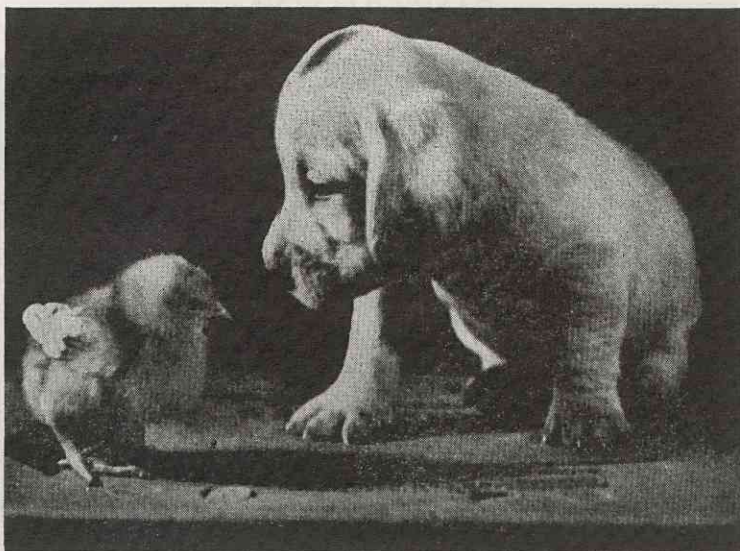


## TRY THIS DAILY DOZEN
