DRIVE BOTH CARS

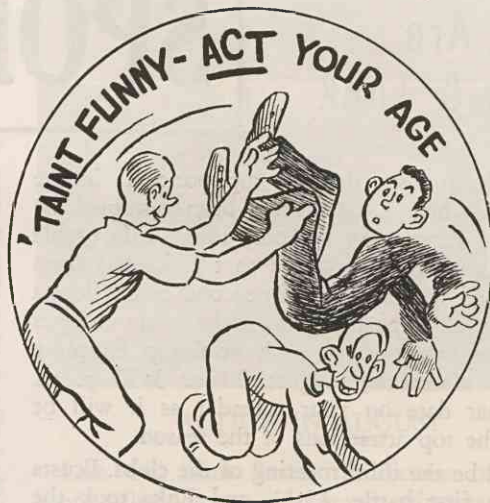
"Drive both cars" means that an expert, alert driver figures out what the other fellow may do, and acts accordingly.
