BOUQUETS TO BOWLERS

The highest individual honor of the season in our bowling league goes to John Emory of the Research Rebels team, who finished the season with the league's highest individual average. John led the top five bowlers of the league with an average of 173 plus 55 pins per game; Chris Rogers was second with a 171 plus 3 pin average; Joe Lavell third with a 170 plus 62 pin average; fourth was Randall Lankford with a 170 plus 3 pin average and the fifth place bowler was Walter Straus with a 170 plus 27 pin average.

Randall Lankford took the highest individual set honors of the season with a 627 pin set. Walter Straus was second best with a 607 pin set and Chris Rogers took the third place honors with a 602 pin set.

The highest individual single game of the season was bowled by Frank Israel, of the Cubs, for a total of 272 pins. The high individual game bowled on each of the other teams was as follows:
